## **MSOA Claimant Count in Tyne & Wear, May 2008**

Published: August 2008

The tables in this document show the estimated Claimant Count Rates in Tyne & Wear, by Local Authority District (LAD) and by Middle Super Output Area (MSOA).

These estimates were produced by TWRI using the ONS Claimant Count for May 2008 and TWRI's estimates of the Economically Active Population in June 2006.

The ONS Claimant Count data was downloaded from NOMISweb ([www.nomisweb.co.uk](http://www.nomisweb.co.uk)).

The estimates for Economically Active Population were calculated by TWRI by taking the MSOA Population of Working Age in 2006 and applying MSOA Economic Activity Rates in 2001 (adjusted to incorporate LAD change in 2001-2006).

It should be stressed that the resulting Claimant Count Rates are not official (ONS) rates or proportions.

Both datasets are available at MSOA-level, and were subsequently aggregated to give District and Tyne & Wear-level totals.
